The above named company is hereby authorized to surface commingle the following pools and acreage within Federal Lease SF-078464 located in Section 24, Township 31 North, Range 13 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico:

Existing Well: Senter Well No. 1C API No. 30-045-31071

This well is dually completed in:

Basin-Dakota (Prorated Gas 71599), S/2 dedication and
Blanco-Mesaverde (Prorated Gas 72319), S/2 dedication.

Condensate, water, and gas allocation between zones shall be accomplished through periodic testing. The sales points for gas and condensate shall be located on this lease.

NOTE: This installation shall be installed and operated in accordance with the applicable provisions of Rule 303 of the Division Rules and Regulations and the Division "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities." It is the responsibility of the producer to notify the transporter of this commingling authority.
