Reference is made to your application for approval of a 309.24-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

E/2 of Section 13**

It is understood that this unit is to be ascribed to your Grenier Well No. 3, located 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the East line of Section 13, in the SW/4 SE/4 of Section 13, Township 31 North, Range 12 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

By authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-128-C, you are hereby authorized to operate the above described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned there-to in accordance with pool rules, based upon the unit size of 309.24 acres.
