Well spudded November 16, 1963. Set 7-5/8" OD casing at 35' and cemented with 12 sacks by hand. W.O.C. 24 hours. Drilled to 1255'.

CORE NO. 1 - 1255 - 1259' (4') - Recovered 3'6"
 Top - 1' - Shale, slightly sandy
 Next - 2' 6" - Gray sand, oil saturated

CORE NO. 2 - 1259 - 1273' (14') - Recovered 11'
 Top - 1' - Dark gray sand, oil saturated
 Next - 1' - Shaley sand, oil saturated
 Next - 1' - Sand, lime and shale, slight show of oil
 Next - 8' - Shale & Lime

Reached total depth of 1305' on November 18, 1963. Set 4-1/2" OD casing at 1300' and cemented with 100 sacks. W.O.C. 24 hours. Shut off tested OK. Did not drill out cement plug at 1291'. FBTD 1291'. Perforated 4-1/2" OD casing from 1250' - 1264' for a total of 6' and 24 shots. Treated through 4-1/2" OD casing perfs. 1250' - 1264' with 40,740 gallons of lease oil and 40,000# 20/40 mesh & 8-7/8" ball sealers. After recovering all lead oil well pumped 16 barrels of oil and no water in 24 hours.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, local laws on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
