**Our coding program is as follows:**

20' - 7-5/8" OD 27.75 Spiral Weld Casing - to be cemented with 10 sacks regular cement.

1000' - 4-1/2" OD 9.50 J-55 Casing - to be cemented with 75 sacks regular cement w/1/2 gal and 250 lbs gilsonite and 25 sacks regular with 2% calcium chloride.

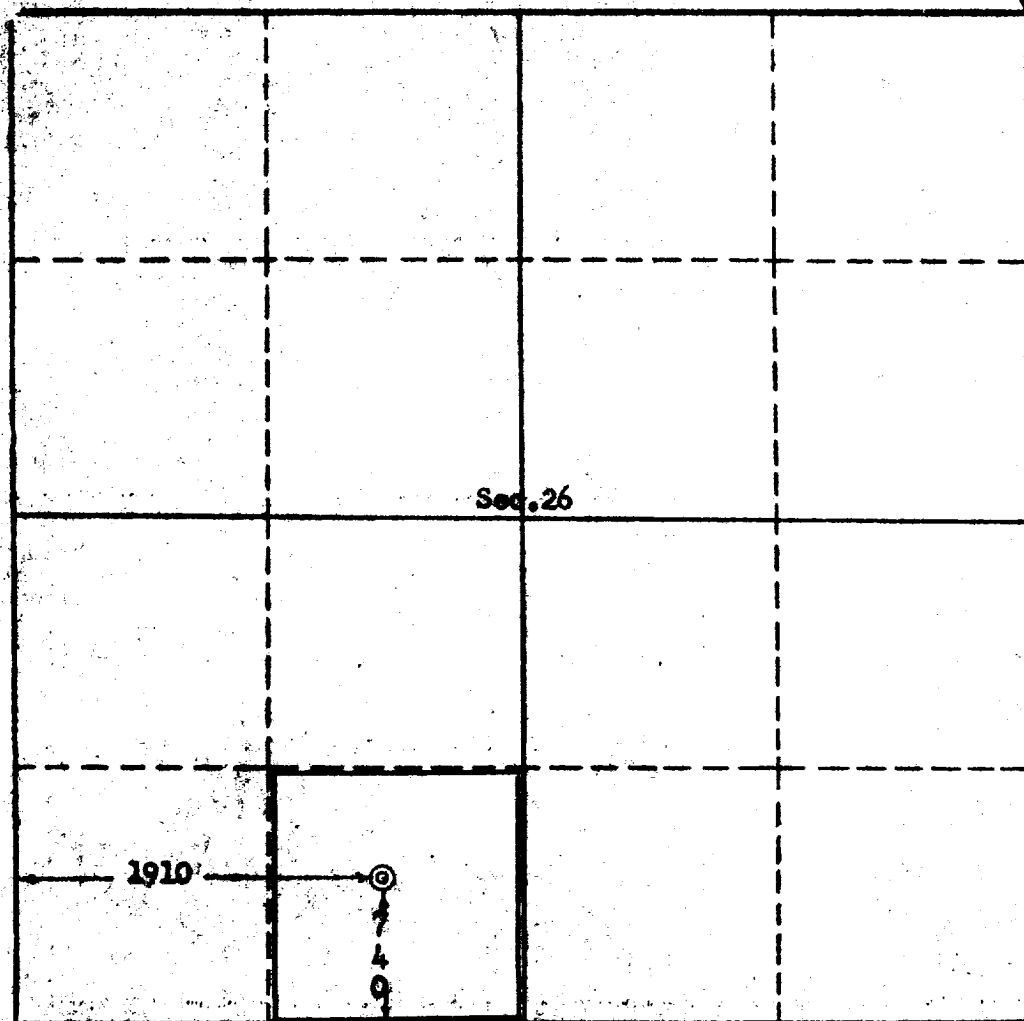

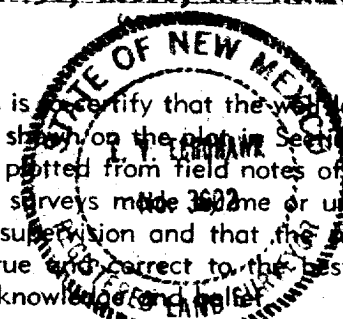
