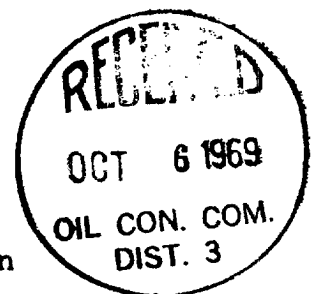
By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3 of Order No. R-1670-C, as amended, the above-described unorthodox well location is hereby approved.
