In August, 1971, you filed an Application for Permit to Drill, with the United States Geological Survey, for Navajo AA #20, 0-8-32N-17W. We have not received any indication that this well was drilled. If not, will you please file Federal Form 9-331, Sundry Notice and Report, with the United States Geological Survey in Farmington stating that the location has been abandoned?

To complete our files we need a Well Record, Federal Form 9-330, and a Subsequent Report of Abandonment, Federal From 9-331, for your Navajo AA #19, B-19-32N-17W.

For your Navajo AA #19-Y we need a Subsequent Report of abandonment.
