An attempt was made to take the deliverability test on the above well; and due to unforeseen conditions in this test, i.e. the well loading up with frac water and formation fluid and excessively high line pressures in the transmission facilities, we have been unable to obtain a satisfactory test on this well. At the present time we are attempting to regulate this well in a manner whereby it can be successfully tested, at which time we would like to schedule the well for a new deliverability test.
