

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

1. "Red" Cox rigged up with hydraulic jacks: The casing was found to be free after the head was unscrewed with 80,000# pull. Seven inch casing was recovered in the amount of 49 joints and two pieces for 1624' overall.
2. Two inch tubing was run to 1630', 25 sax of gel were mixed to place heavy mud opposite the open hole. The 50 sax of regular cement were spotted at 1630 and the tubing was pulled out of the hole.
3. The 10 3/4" casing flange was removed
4. A 25 sax cement plug was spotted in top of the 10 3/4" casing and a ten' piece of 4" pipe was cemented in the top of the casing with 4' above the mean ground level. The location was cleaned up and the well sign left on the location.
