## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Workover # 2 with the Gas rotary rig ended 9-22-52. The top string of cable tools was removed from the hole leaving the prongs off a 3 prong grab in the hole plus the line and a second string of cable tools believed to be at about 4500'. During workover # 2 5 attempts were made with a center soear, 7 attempts with lead and tar impression blocks, 2 tapered mills, a 4 3/4" Reed bit, a 5" OD "slick joint", and a two prong grab. It was therefore decided to plug and abandon the hole. This notice is in compliance with the several conversations with members of the New Mexico Conservation Commission. It is further proposed to:

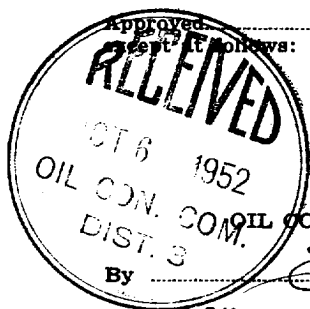
1. Pull 7" casing - recovering as much as possible. The casing was found to be parted at 1630' or where all the above fishing took place.
2. Run 2" tubing to 1630 and mix a heavy mud to leave on top of the cement. Mix 50 sack of regular cement at 1630. Remove tubing.
3. Remove 10 3/4" casing flange
4. Spot 10-20 sack plug in top of 10 3/4" casing and leave with 4" marker 4' above the ground. Clean up location.
