Dear Mr. Harr:

We have just received Notice of Intention to Drill on your #2 Estate of Edward Sargent well located 475 feet from the North and 321 feet from the East lines of Section 8-32N-3E.

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations require that a well be located no closer than 330 feet to the boundary line of the 40-acre tract on which it is located. Your location is therefore non-standard in the amount of 9 feet.

WCHS We are wondering if it would be possible for you to move your location to a standard location in order that it might be a standard location. If the well is drilled in this location and production is secured it will be necessary to hold a hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission for approval of the location before oil could be produced.

Will you please advise.
