

DETAILS OF WORK

Notice of intention to Abandon Well, Form 7-11a, was approved January 29, 1952. Well was permanently plugged and abandoned as follows: 1. Filled hole with 12 pound mud from bottom of hole to 3370 feet; 2. Plugged hole with solid cement from 3370 to 2893 feet; 3. Shot off 7" casing five times at following depths: at 1793 feet, at 1613 feet, at 1473 feet, at 1337 feet, at 1199 feet, but unable to pull casing. 7" casing shot free at 1061 feet and 1058 feet of 7" casing was recovered; 4. August 20, 1952, plugged hole with solid cement from 1066 to 1077 feet and from 33 feet to surface; 5. Filled hole with 12 pound mud from 2893 to 1066 feet and from 1077 to 33 feet; 6. Erected 4' pipe marker and restored ground level to original contours as per regulations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
