Dear Mary Ellen:


Benson-Montin-Greer Drilling Corp. has received the Well Completions Reported and Not Reported print out from your Santa Fe office. The Puerto Chiquito #24 (A-9) well is showing on the Oil Conservation Division records as it should be reported on Form C115. Our BMG records show this well was plugged 3-4-81.

I have contacted Brian Davis, engineer with the BLM, Albuquerque office, with a request for any information about this well. He has researched the BLM records for this lease and found a reference to the well, but no well file information. He stated these records could have gone to archives, but not able to locate those files that might be in Roswell, Farmington, or Albuquerque. He has suggested perhaps a picture of the dry hole marker might be sufficient evidence of plugging.

We have in our well file a copy of Subsequent Report of Abandonment on a Sundry Notice dated 7-20-82. This notice is not signed by BMG or approved by the BLM. At your request I have enclosed this document.

2-25-81 Moved in B-M-G Rig 13 to plug and abandon well.

3- 2-81 Spotted bottom hole cement plug 10 sacks (2 bbls. slurry) down 2-3/8" tubing set 1 foot above PBTD. (Cement plug from 1796' to 1575').  
Pulled tubing open ended at 545'. Spotted 25 sacks (5 bbls. slurry) down 2-3/8" tubing. Circulated cement to surface. (Cement plug from 545' to surface).

3- 4-81 Erected dry hole marker. Cleaned location and moved off.

Requested by Mr. Sims to explain on Sundry Notice the sequence of events and dates that resulted in failure of operator to comply with attachment to Notice of Intention to Abandon as approved March 23, 1981.
