FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

Drilled to 3675', through igneous rock. No shows or water sands encountered. We intend to set 13 3/8 surface casing at 404' and cement to surface. Will set 9 5/8 protection casing at 1217' with cement. We intend to fill the well with heavy mud from TD to 1350'. Spot cement plug from 1350 up into the 9 5/8 casing to 1150'. Will cut off surface pipe, fill with heavy mud and place cement plug with 4' marker pipe in top of cement plug, in accordance with the telephone conversation of July 12, 1960, with Emery Arnold.
