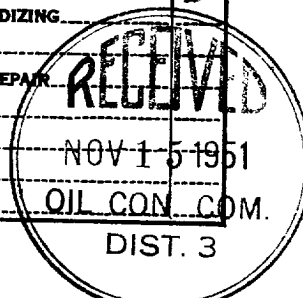

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded on October 30, 1951, with cable tool rig. On October 31, 1951, 10-3/4" casing was landed at 103 feet with 110 sacks of cement. Cement circulated to surface. Plugged down at 2:35 P.M. on October 31, 1951. Cable tool rig moved off and rotary rig moved on. On November 3, 1951, tested casing and water shut-off with 350 pounds pressure for 30 minutes with no drop in pressure. Drilled 41 feet of solid cement in bottom of pipe and water shut-off was again tested with 300 pounds for 30 minutes. No drop in pressure. Drilling operations were resumed.
