## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well was drilled to a total depth of 2150 feet in August, 1950. 7" casing was set at 2015 feet and open hole interval 2030 to 2095 feet shot with 200 quarts SNG. Well was cleaned out to total depth with no signs of oil and/or gas. As reported on Form C-102 dated November 27, 1950, well has been shut in since August 16, 1950.

It is proposed to plug and abandon this well permanently as follows: 1. Plug hole with solid cement from bottom of hole to 2000 feet; 2. Shoot off casing above 2000 feet in order to recover maximum footage 7" casing; 3. Fill hole with 12 pound mud up to 460 feet; 4. Plug hole with solid cement necessary to fill hole from top of mud to surface of hole; 5. Erect 4' pipe marker and restore ground level to original contours as per regulations.
