DETAILS OF WORK

We drilled a 7 7/8 hole to a total depth of 1660' with no oil or gas shows. We propose to plug and abandon this well as follows.

Place a 50 sack plug from 1555' to 1383'.
Place a 25 sack plug from 141' to 65'.
Place a 10 sack plug in the top of the surface casing.
Erect a dry hole marker
Fill cellar and all pits
Level and clean up location

We propose to re-seed this area in the spring when weather permits.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
