DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was spudded October 26, 1950, and drilled to T.D. 1420'. 7" casing cemented in top of Pictured Cliffs sand at 1420' (50 sacks). Hole drilled to T.D. 1520'. Gas encountered 1430' - 1480' and this section shot with 240 qts, Nitro-glycerin. Shot broke water in from above, the hole plugged back to 1430', and 60 sacks of cement was squeezed in through 2" tubing by Halliburton. The hole now stands as a shut in gas well and will remain so until title of the lease has been judicially determined.
