Dear Sir:

On February 16, 1962 a Notice of Intention to Drill was filed for a well known as the K.A. Flader Land Company #1 Crawford, located 2125 feet from the North line and 1010 feet from the West Line of Section 30-29N-11%. The well was to be drilled to a depth of 800 feet in the Farmington Sandstone.

No further information was ever filed on this location, although we have determined by a field inspection that a well was drilled on this location. You are, therefore, in violation of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations and we hereby direct that all miscellaneous notices and well record form as required by law be filed indicating how deep the well was drilled, formations penetrated, casing strings cemented and any other pertinent data. We are also directing that some final disposition of the well must be made within the next 30 days. We presume the well was not a commercial producer and will therefore require that either your company or the bonding company who issued your plugging bond plug the well according to Commission requirements.

May we please hear from you regarding this matter.
