Gentlemen:

The above well was drilled in 1938 and completed as an oil well in the Farmington sandstone. In February, 1960 Burger Drilling Company assumed operation of the well. No production has been reported from this well in the last year and we presume that it has ceased producing. We are therefore directing that it be plugged and abandoned in accordance with New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules and regulations. Form C-102 should be submitted for approval of your plugging plan prior to commencing operations.

If some action is not instituted within the next 30 days it is our intention to set the matter for hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission in order that the operator and the bonding company may show cause why the well should not be properly plugged and abandoned.
