Dear Dr. Kendall:

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division, as part of its Underground Injection Control authority, requires Kendall & Associates to perform an MIT on the above disposal well once every five years. An MIT was due on this well April 2, 1992.

The mechanical integrity of the casing-tubing annulus is tested by submitting the annulus to a pressure of 300 psi for 30 minutes with less than ten percent bleed-off as outlined in Commission Rule 704. Kendall & Associates is required to complete the MIT by November 1, 1992.

We require a 24 to 48 hour notice so that we may be present to witness testing. Kendall & Associates will furnish personnel and equipment to complete the tests.
