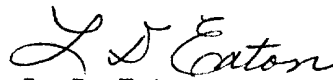
Gentlemen:

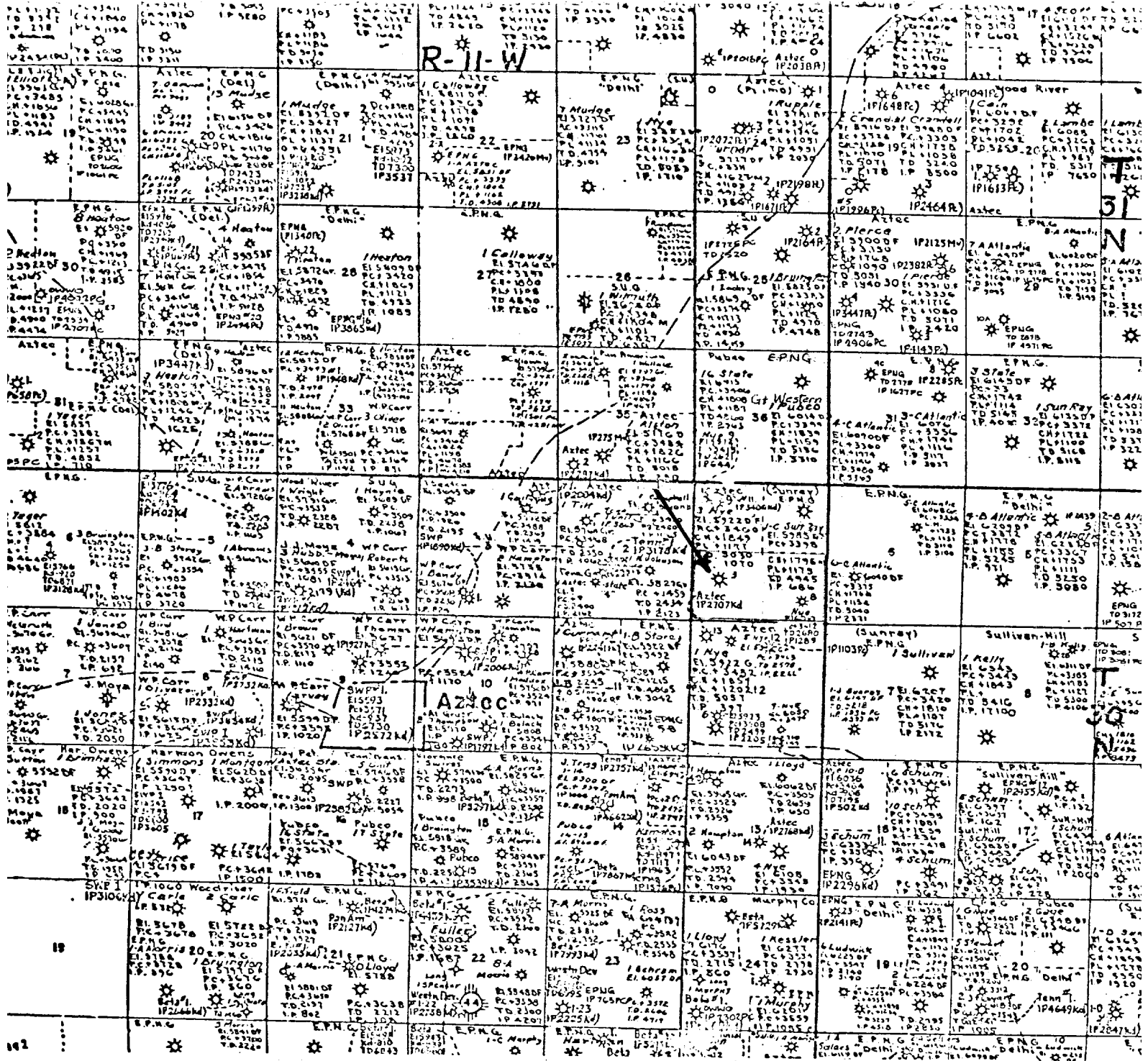
