

THE APPLICATION OF AZTEC OIL & GAS
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-2028

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on April 16, 1973, for permission to dually complete its Nye Well No. 3 located in Unit L of Section 1, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool.

Now, on this 6th day of May, 1973, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Nye Well No. 3 located in Unit L of Section 1, Township 30 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

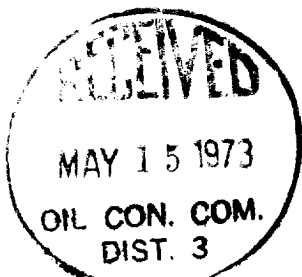
PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A, Areas Oil & Gas Company
has applied to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission for
a permit to drill a well in the 10th North, Range 11 West,
County of Lincoln, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce
oil from the adjacent Cattle Pool and the Blanco-Mosquero
Pool.

That on this 15th day of May, 1957, the Secretary-Director
finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions
of Rule 115-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all
operations of the well shall be conducted in such a manner as to

prevent the production of oil from the adjacent Cattle Pool and
the Blanco-Mosquero Pool.

(3) That the proposed well completion will not cause waste
of oil or gas.

(4) That the completion of the proposed well completion will
not cause waste of oil or gas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Areas Oil & Gas Company, be and the
same is hereby authorized to drill a well in the 10th North,
Range 11 West, County of Lincoln, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce
oil from the adjacent Cattle Pool and the Blanco-Mosquero
Pool, and to operate the same during the term of the permit.

That the applicant shall comply with all provisions of Rule 115-A,
and shall file in accordance with the provisions of Rule 115-A,

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take such steps as may be
necessary to prevent the production of oil from the adjacent Cattle Pool and
the Blanco-Mosquero Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That completion of this permit is
conditionally retained for the entry of such further orders as the
Commission may deem necessary.
