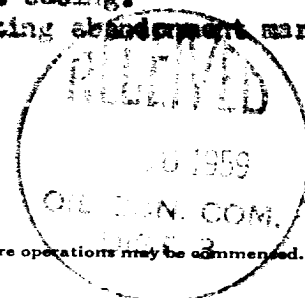

DETAILS OF WORK

Rosa Unit 35-5 was plugged and abandoned at total depth of 753 feet as follows on August 21, 1959, due to collapsed surface casing:

1. Spotted 200 sacks of cement plug 82 feet - 332 feet in base of surface casing from collapsed depth to above parted joint.
2. Spotted 10 sacks of cement plug in top of surface casing.
3. Welded cap on 13-3/8 inch casing in lieu of erecting abandonment marker due to proximity of skidded location.



I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
