That the applicant herein, Astec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Grenier Well No. 1 located in Unit O of Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 11 West, NHPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Astec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
