

October 15, 1958 Intermediate pipe was set on the above described well. The hole was reamed to 12 1/4" to 3817 ft. The pipe consisted of 91 fts. 3803' 8 5/8" J-55 32# new J & L casing. It was set at 3816 ft. K.B. and cemented with 430 sks. 50% Pozmix, 50 % cement with 1/2 gal followed with 100 sks. regular. Good returns throughout.
