Gentlemen:

This unorthodox location is due to the topography of the section and the well as surveyed will be on the sharp point at the junction of two canyon walls. The only possible spot for an orthodox location has already been used by El Paso Natural Gas Company and in order to locate this well on the same point, keep out of the canyon, and be far enough away from the other well it was necessary to place it at 1350' F/SL and 790' F/WL.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission has advised they have no objection to granting administrative approval for this proposed location. However, in accordance to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Dakota Gas Pool if you object to this location; please notify the Oil Conservation Commission, P. O.
