Comments on Inspection:

RECEIVED A PHONE CALL FROM MR CARL LANE JOHNSON-RANCHER IN REFERENCE TO ROAD CONDITIONS OF LEASE ROAD INTO THIS WELL. EROSION HAS BEGUN TODETERIORATE ROAD, TRAFFIC HAS STARTED DRIVING OFF THE LEASE ROAD INTO THE PASTURE TO GET TO THE WELL SITE. AFTER A CALL TO STATE LAND OFFICE, DISTRICT RESOURCE MANAGER, MR. BILL SONNAMAKER HE ADVISED THAT UNDER THE RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT THE OPERATOR AGREES TO MAINTAIN THE ROAD TO THE WELL SITE WE ARE REQUESTING OXY TO TAKE STEPS TO REPAIR LEASE ROAD TO PREVENT FUTURE TRAFFIC DRIVING IN PASTURE AREA TAKE IN CONSIDERATION WATER BARS TO ASSIST IN EROSION PREVENTION ALSO NEED TO REMOVE JUNK OR SURPLUS CABLE, CEMENT BLOCKS, CONDUIT AND UNUSED STEEL FLOWLINE FROM THIS SITE. THIS IS 1ST LETTER OF NON-COMPLIANCE.



Such a hearing may result in imposition of CIVIL PENALTIES for your violation of OCD rules


