Legacy Reserves Operating LP requests BLM approval to permanently abandon the current open hole wellbore below the 9 5/8" intermediate casing at 5400' and temporarily abandon the well pending an evaluation of a possible sidetrack in the 9 5/8" casing at approximately 5370'. We propose setting a cement plug on top of the current 7" casing fish at 6034'. The cement plug is proposed to be 400 sacks of Class "C" cement containing 2% CaCl (1.32 CF/sx yield) which is designed to fill the entire 8 3/4" open hole interval from 5400'-6034' at 50% excess to account for hole washouts and to possibly bring cement inside the 9 5/8", 40# casing to 5000'. We propose waiting on cement 8 hours, then tagging to verify the cement top. ~~Should the cement top be found to be below the 9 5/8" casing shoe at 5400', we propose to set a cast iron bridge plug in the 9 5/8" casing at 5380' and spot 50sx (155') Class "C" neat cement on top of the plug. The well would then be temporarily abandoned for an estimated time period of 100 days to allow Hamon Fed Com A #'s 2H and 4H to be drilled and the completion of an evaluation to determine the best course of action to take on the~~

1. Operator shall tag top of plug at a minimum of 50' above the 9-5/8" shoe. Tag approximately 5350 or shallower. (it is required to have a shoe plug per on shore orders) Tag to be witness by BLM.
2. Operator has the option of bring the cement plug 150' above the 9-5/8" shoe.
3. The operator shall properly secure the 9-5/8" casing with a minimum of a blind flange and a pressure gage installed.
4. Within 90 days operator shall submit a Sundry to the BLM requesting additional evaluation time and/or a drilling proposal to sidetrack the well or plug the well.

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
