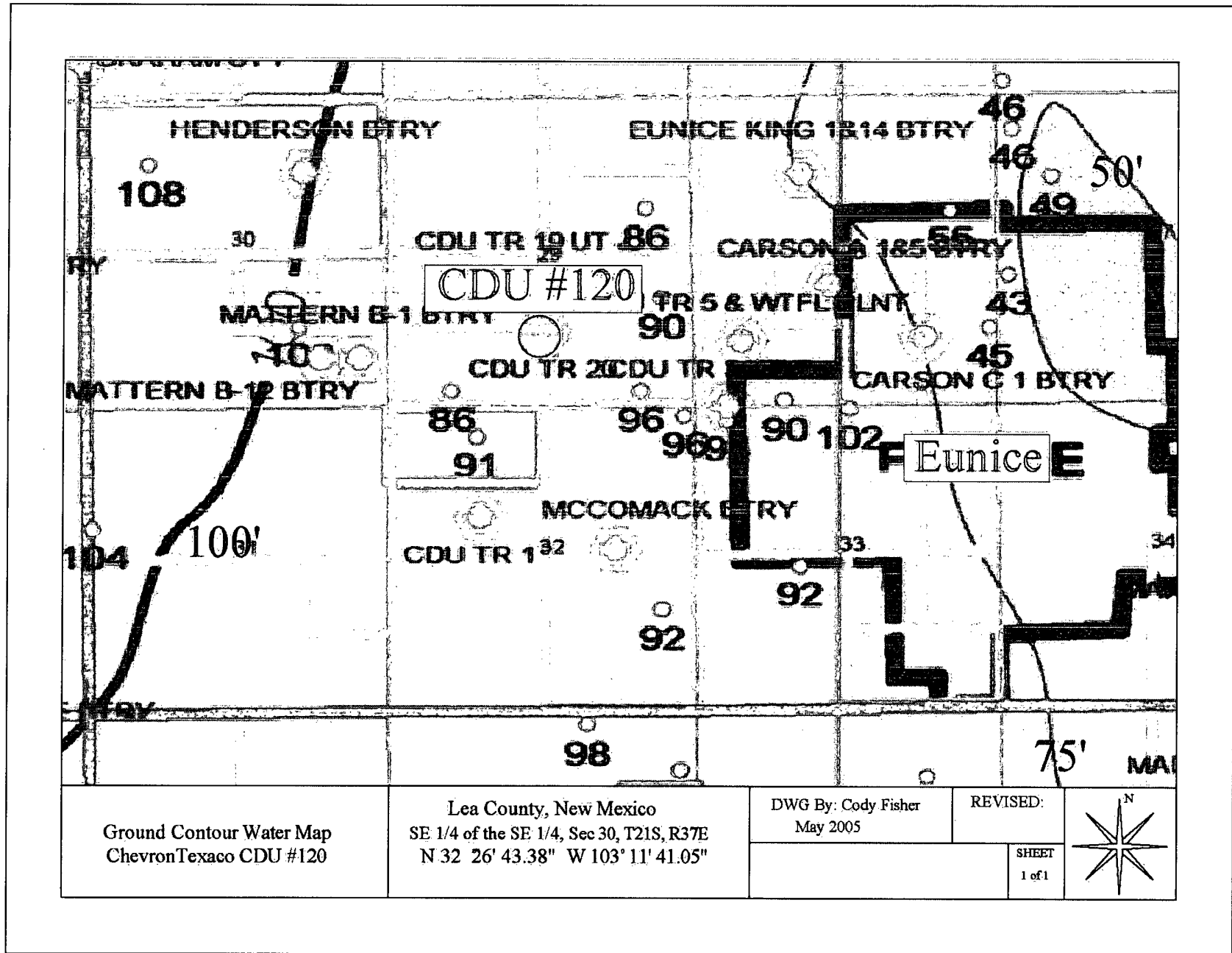

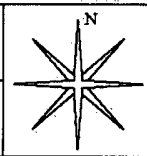


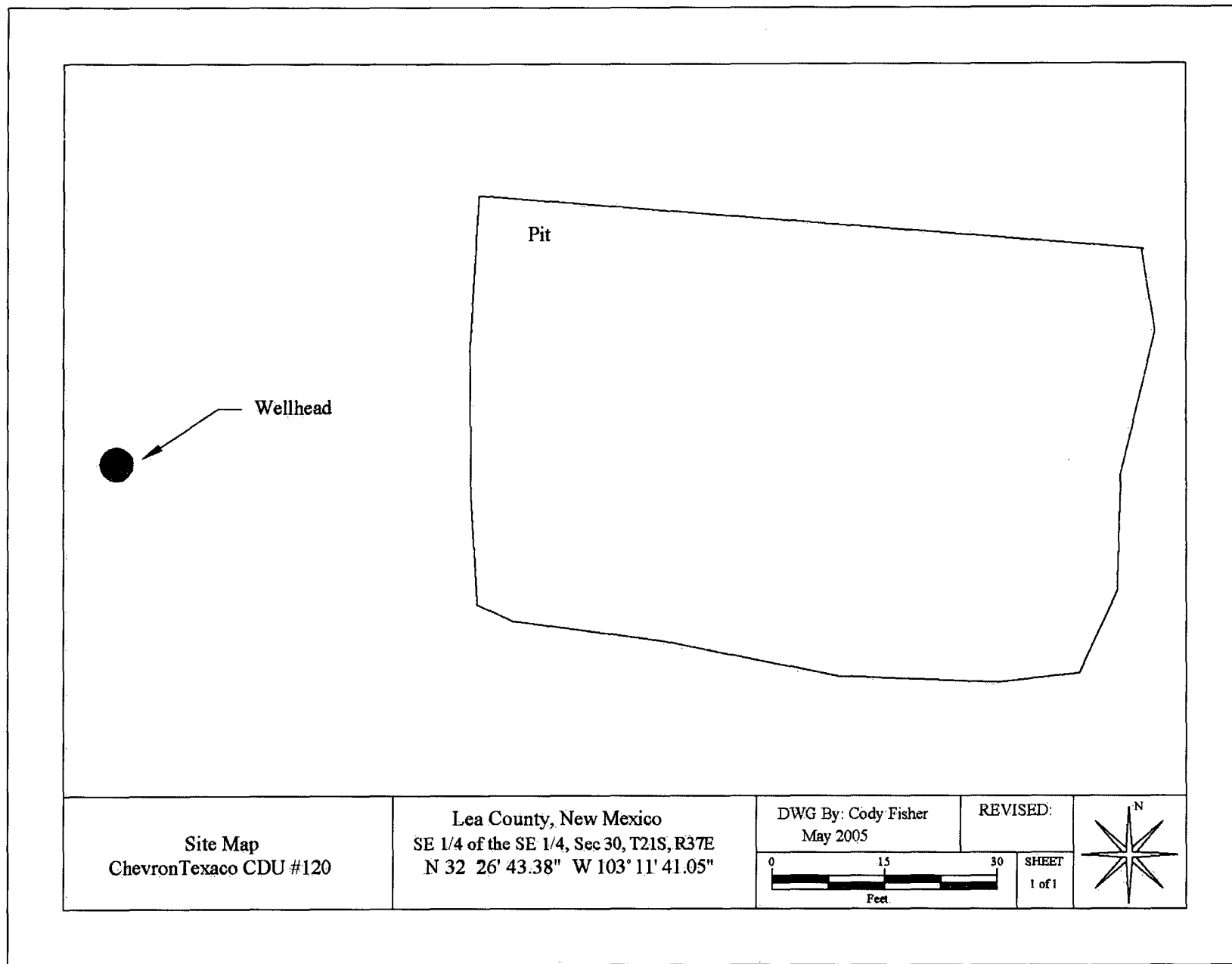
Ground Contour Water Map

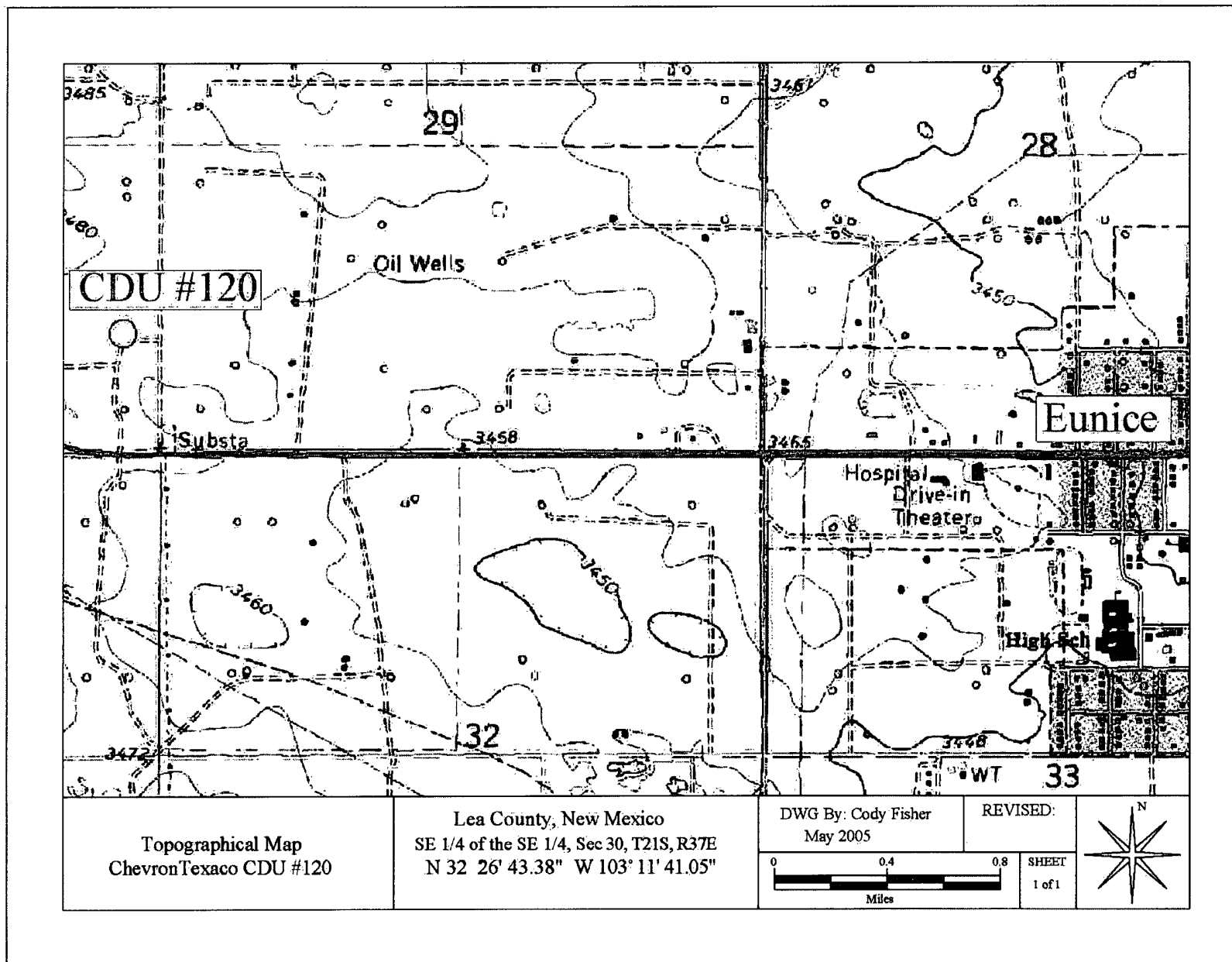

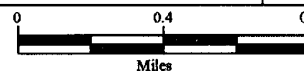


Topographical Map

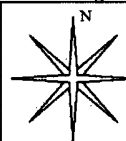

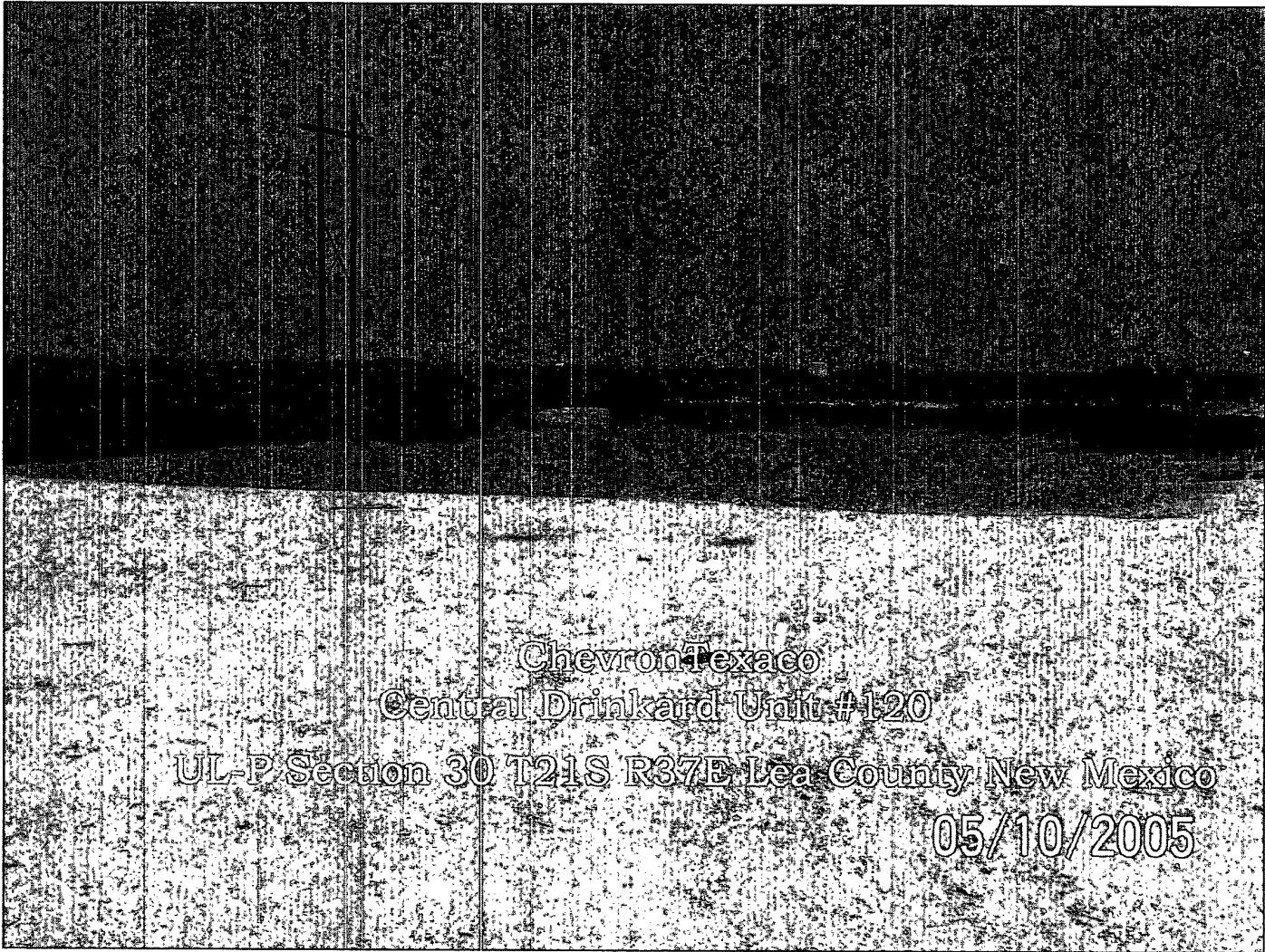
