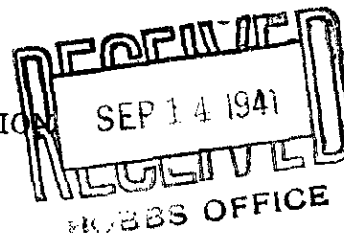

## MISCELLANEOUS REPORTS ON WELL

It should be signed and sworn to before a notary public for reports on beginning drilling operations, results of shooting well, results of test of casing shut-offs, result of plugging of well, and other important operations, even though the work was witnessed by an agent of the commission. Reports on minor operations need not be signed and sworn to before a notary public. See additional instructions in the Rules and Regulations of the Commission.

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

At 3:00 A. M., September 10th, 1941, 72 hours had elapsed since setting 5-1/2" Casing at 3517' with 225 sacks of cement.

At that time, we tested casing in the following manner:

Built up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. Test was okay; drilled plug; again built up 1000# pressure and held for 30 minutes. This test was okay, too; drilling was resumed.
