Perf the Lower 1st Bone Spring Sand 8227-31', 8278-87' (15) and acidize with 1500 gals. NE Fe 7.5% HCL. If decision made to frac, frac with 125,000 lbs sand.

Perf the Upper 1st Bone Spring Sand 8104-18' (30) and acidize with 750 gals. NE Fe 7.5% HCL. If decision made to frac, frac with 60,000 lbs sand.

Perf the Upper "A" Carb 7922-26' (10) and acidize with 500 gals. NE Fe 20% HCL.
