9/23/03: Perforated, through-tubing from 14,235.5' to 14,244.5' with 6 SPF, a total of 54 holes. The tubing had 3200 psi pressure on it before perforating. Left the well shut-in for two days after perforating with no increase or decrease in pressure, indicating no fluid or gas entry or loss.

10/16/03: After three weeks of production, there is no indication that the perforated interval from 14,235.5' to 14,244.5' is contributing any oil, gas or water to the production stream. Since there is no production contribution from this zone, there will be no need to apply for downhole commingling.
