TOTAL DEPTH 12,250'. We ran 12,250' of 5 1/2" 20# N-80 S.S. Casing, cemented with 700 sacks of cement. We plan to test casing shut-off at nine o'clock A.M., April 26th, 1948, with 1000# pump pressure for one hour.

Note:

We originally planned to cement with 1200 sacks of cement, but in checking with Halliburton they advised it would be impossible to circulate this much cement at this depth and we cemented, as shown above, with 700 sacks.
