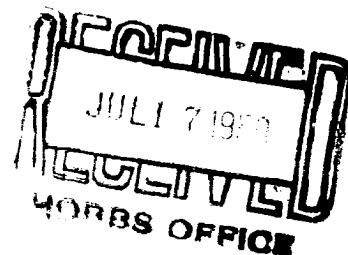

T. D. 4615' Lime. We ran 4614' of 9 5/8 casing. Cemented with 2700 and 800 sacks of cement. (2 stages). Cement circulated back to surface.

Casing shut off was tested July 12, 1950 at 8 P. M. for one hour with 1000# pump pressure. Casing shut off tested ok.
