Set bridging plug at 9284 ft. Perforated 52 holes from 9262-75 ft. Packer at 9147 ft. Acidised with 500 gals. thru perforations 9262-75 ft. - formation break at 4500 psi on tubing. Swabbed 17 hours and recovered slight amount of water from formation; no shows of oil or gas.
