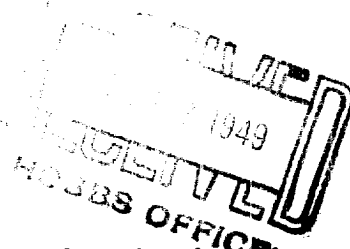

Set bridging plug at 9733 ft. Perforated 20 holes with jet gun at 9720 to 9725. (Very
Ran 2 1/2" tubing on packer set at 9696 ft., swabbed 2 to 3 bbls. of brackish to light
slightly salty water per hour off bottom. Acidized with 1000 gals. 20% acid and gas
swabbed over 20 bbls. per hour of salty sulfur water; fluid level could not be show)
lowered below 2000 ft. No oil show was detected; swabbed 21 hours.

Now preparing to set bridging plug and perforate from 9680 to 9685 ft.
