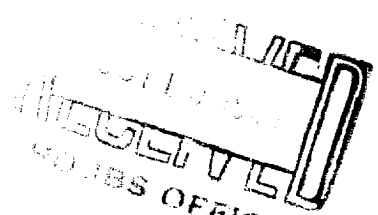

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

X Acidized with 1000 gals. some 10720-746 perfs. 10725 to 10733.6 20% acid by Western Co., injection pressure 2800 psi at injection rate of .3 bbls. per minute; casing pressure remained constant at 2600 psi. Swabbed dry after acidization; no shows of either oil, gas, or water. Set McGullough Type "B" bridging plug at 10686 ft., then Jet-perforated 30 holes from 10626 to 10636 ft. in zone from 10622 to 10638 ft. Now swabbing thru 2 1/2" HV.

XX CASING SHUTOFF ABOVE PACKER SET AT 10698 ft. Casing was tested during the above acidization, - for 2:45 hrs. the pressure held at 2600 psi.
