FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Well drilled to T. D. of 12657 ft. in Devonian line topped at 12605 feet. Took 2 hour drill stem test with packer at 12605 ft., recovered 6750 ft. of drilling mud and out with salt water and saltwater. We propose to pump 75 sack plug in 8 1/4" hole above and below basal Mississippian and top of Devonian; then run approx. 10770 ft. of 7" OD casing, cement case, then squeeze and test possible productive zones in the Pennsylvanian and Permian back to 1240 feet.
