DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Tested the 5 1/2" H-80 17 & 20# Pittsburgh Sals casing set at 11775 ft. before drilling the HOWCO squeeze packer set at 10940 ft. and again before drilling the HOWCO combination float & shoe at 11775 ft. Found 2 ft. of cement below the shoe. Casing was tested to 1100 psi and 1000 psi; the pressure "held" the required period.
