## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

## FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Drilled 12 1/4" hole from surface pipe (312.5) to 4248'. Ran 4221.5 ft. of 9 5/8" OD & 4 1/2" J-55 casing and cemented in two stages at 4236 ft. with staging tool at 3204 ft. Pumped 750 sz. neat cement in first stage and when tool opened circulated 10 sz. Circulated for 4 Hr., pumped 2100 sz 4% bulk in 2nd stage, circulating cement. Left 100 ft. cement above shoe and collar, plug down on 2nd stage 10:30 PM 6-20. Cement volumes computed from caliper survey.

Plan to allow cement to set approximately 50 hours and pressure test both before and after drilling plugs, in each case to pressure casing to 1000 psi and allow to stand over 50 minutes.

The testing will be performed by Mr. Lee Thompson of the G.P. Livermore, Inc., contractor.
