Perforated 5 1/2" liner from 8917-27'. Treated with 500 gallons and 2500 gallons acid. Recovered load then swabbed 21 bbls salt water in 2 1/2 hours.

Mixed 35 sacks cement. Squeezed approximately 20 sacks into perforations 8917-27'. Left plug from 8830-8927.

Request permission to plug above perforations and perforate and test from 4877-83. This confirms oral approval given May 20 and June 1, 1964.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
