We set a Baker Bridging Plug at 12365'. Gun perforated from 12360' to 12240' 3 holes per foot. Acidized with 1000 gals. mud acid to 3000 lbs. would not break formation. Dry

We then set a Baker Bridging Plug at 9800'. Gun perforated 9710' to 9724' with 34 shots. Acidized with 500 gals. mud acid to 3000 lbs. would not break formation down. Perforated with jet shots from 9695' to 9710' swabbed 20 bbls. salt water per hr.

Cement was spotted to cover casing perforations at 9695 to 9724. Hole was loaded with heavy mud laden fluid, 5 1/8" csg was shot off and 8068' recovered. 75 sack plug of cement was spotted at ^{for of} casing left in hole, 50 sack cement plug spotted at 4735 and 50 sack cement plug placed in top of 9 5/8 casing. 9 5/8" casing was bull plugged, cellar was filled and regulation marker was placed over well bore.
