Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.

The hole was loaded with a mud and a plug consisting of 25 sacks of cement was spotted at bottom of 7" casing (12254). 7" casing was shot off at 9435 and recovered casing. A 15 sx. cement plug was spotted at 9440-9420. A 50 sx. cement plug was spotted from 7000'. A 35 sx cement plug was spotted at bottom of 9-5/8" casing (4178'). 1 bridging plug at 3600' & 1 bridging plug at 200' with 21 sx cement plug at surface w/4" pipe (stenciled) at surface. Well plugged and abandoned November 14, 1955.
