DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 355' of 9-5/8" 40# and 3823' of 9-5/8" 36# Seamless J-55 casing (total of 4178') and set at 4190'. Cemented with 2700 sacks of Dia-Mix and 200 sacks of Neat. Circulated 175 sacks. Tested pipe and casing seat with 1100 psi for 30 minutes before and after the drilling out of the cement and both held OK.
