Well spudded June 24, 1954.

Ran 298' of 13 3/8" 48# Seamless H-40 casing and set at 313'.  
Cemented with 300 sacks of Neat and circulated 10 sacks. Tested  
pipe and casing seat with 800 psi for 30 minutes before and after  
the drilling out of the cement on June 27, 1954 and both held O.K.
