T.D. 5301 S.L.M. No commercial oil and gas found. Sulphur water appeared at 5277 and rose 2300' in hole in 36 hours. Intend to plug from 5301 to 5000 with cement; from 5000 to 4400 with gravel and cement; have Halliburton fill hole with heavy mud, as pipe is pulled and set 25 sack plug of cement, at both bottom and top of sale (2830 bottom) 2360 top). Mud to top, place cement plug in 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  casing which will remain in hole; then set conventional 4" marker, at least 5' above surface.
