DETAILS OF WORK

The Great Western Drilling Company, Federal MM #1 was spudded November 21, 1960. On November 22, 1960, 407' of 10-3/4" 32#, J-55 casing was cemented @ 422' with 150 sacks plus 11 Cu ft. P.D. @ 3:30 PM, cement circulated after 24 hrs. exposure of 800 psi was applied at the surface. There was no pressure loss in 30 minutes. Drilling was resumed.
