DETAILS OF WORK

Well plugged and abandoned as follows: Recovered 4097' of 8-5/8" casing and 1600' of 8-5/8" casing of original 4275' of 8-5/8" and 9785' of 5 1/2" casing run; spotted 50 sx cement over 5 1/2" csg. perforations at 9728-9732; set 25 sx cement in and out of 5 1/2" casing stub; set 100' of cement in base of 8-5/8" casing at 4275'; 50 sx cement set in top of 8-5/8" casing at 2675'. Set 100' cement plug in base of 13-3/8" casing at 365', and set 20 sx cement in top of 13-3/8" casing with proper U.S.G.S. marker installed. Hole filled with heavy mud between plugs. Location cleaned up, junk removed, pits leveled, ready for inspection.

Verbal permission to plug as above obtained from Mr. Standley in March, 1963.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
