DST No. 2 made from 11,577 feet to 11,639 feet (62 feet). Length of test - 1 hour. Very weak blow when tool was first opened, remained dead for ~~one~~ hour. Recovered 2250 feet of water blanket, no show of either oil or gas. Initial flowing pressure 1180#, final flowing pressure 1180#. 30 minute bottom hole shut in pressure 1315#. Hydrostatic pressure in 5880#, out 5890#. Test made on November 23, 1956.
