## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Testing of 9-5/8" OD, 36#, New, J-55, LT&C intermediate casing set at 4351 feet and cemented with 1550 sacks Lone Star Incore cement and 1325 sacks Sulphate Resisting Pozmix, cement did not circulate. Top of cement behind 9-5/8" OD, 1320 feet below surface by Temperature Survey. Tested 9-5/8" OD and blow out preventer with 1500# water pressure for 30 minutes, no pressure decline.
